The problem with most AI procurement projects

Most organisations are approaching AI in procurement the wrong way. They're taking existing processes — category planning, supplier onboarding, spend analysis, sourcing events — and adding AI tools on top. The result is marginal efficiency gains, low adoption, and a growing stack of technology that nobody fully uses

The opportunity is much bigger than that

AI doesn't just speed up procurement tasks. It fundamentally changes which tasks humans need to do at all — and which decisions need to be made differently, faster, or at a different level of the organisation. Capturing that opportunity requires a redesign, not an upgrade

What AI-native procurement redesign means

An AI-native procurement model starts from a clean sheet. Instead of asking “how can AI help us do this better?”, it asks: “if we were building this process today, knowing what AI can do, what would it look like?”

The answer is usually quite different from what most procurement functions have today

- Spend analysis and market intelligence become continuous, not periodic
- Category strategies are built on live data, not quarterly reviews
- Sourcing events are leaner, faster, and more analytically rigorous
- Contract compliance and supplier performance monitoring move from reactive to proactive
- Procurement's human bandwidth shifts from data gathering to judgment, relationships, and negotiation

The result is a procurement function that is smaller, faster, and more commercially impactful than its traditional equivalent — and that scales without headcount.
